Matthew is a funny, smart & caring young man. At 15 months old, he was diagnosed with a rare condition called Metabolic Myopathy/Cytopathy at the mitochondrial level. Matthew has outlived his life expectancy by 18 years.

We believe providing him with meaningful activities in a supportive, barrier-free environment has given him the drive & strength to forge on.

Matthew's MIGHTY Mission strives to make these activities accessible via family sessions using adapted technology & adapted play. Like Matthew, all persons deserve to be empowered with the resources to engage with family/community via play.

Our Mission

To empower all persons with disabilities by providing knowledge, resources, and improving connections to their families/communities through modified play, adapted toys, and innovative technology in a barrier-free environment.

What is MMM?

We are a non-profit organization striving to give persons with disabilities the tools to connect to their families/communities and increase independence through meaningful play and adapted technology.

What do we Provide?

1. An Initial Assessment

Implemented by founder, Certified Recreational Therapist & mother to Matthew, Mary Nagy. This Assessment measures each individual's functioning levels, needs and defecit areas.

2. Program Plan

A developed & person-specific program plan with notes from each session and educational resources

3. Take Home Bag

At the end of each session, the family takes home a bag of activities specifically chosen to engage that person and focus on increasing his/her functioning level. The family will exchange this bag at the next month's session for a new one

4. Monthly Play Sessions

These 60min sessions educate and guide the family through using play to engage with their special needs loved one. Including specific techniques, toys & activities to address their loved-ones defecits. This session incoporates the use of our adapted technology to engage with each individual, allowing them the tools to communicate.

Adapted Technology

Interactive Tablet Program

Includes activities & tools with an interactive iPad program used to increase a wide range of functionality (fine-motor, cognitive, emotional & social skills)



Eye Gaze Bar

Easily clickable mice & large buttons allow participants to choose objects on the screen with minimal assistance, providing control over one's environment






Cost for a Yearly Membership


